### ELLA'S STORY

On March 12, 2008, police were called to a shocking scene at the former residence of Christine Abrams in Cocoa. Police were horrified by what they found: the decomposing body of Ella, Abrams' one year old three-legged German Shepherd dog, who had been locked in a crate with **NO FOOD OR WATER** for months. Ella's frail white paw stuck out through the bars that were her **prison** and her **agony**, as if she were reaching for the bag of food that was only feet away. While Ella suffered a slow torturous death, **starving and crying**, with no one to hear her **pain-filled whimpers**, killer Christine Abrams was dancing and partying, smiling and laughing, as she bragged on her MySpace page. The malicious and senseless death of Ella is not the first act of cruelty Ella endured at the hands of Abrams. Christine Abrams tethered Ella, and left her neglected and unsupervised for an unknown number of days which resulted in Ella's leg being badly strangled. The damage from the **tether** was so **extensive** that Abrams had Ella's **leg amputated**. Christine Abrams has a **history of animal cruelty**, and when she left Ella locked in that crate, she knew what would happen to Ella, and Abrams' intent was to kill her. **Be with us** as we pack the courtroom and the courthouse lawn to show Ella's killer, the Prosecutor, and the Judge that **WE WANT JUSTICE FOR ELLA** and all other animals that **suffer** and share Ella's **merciless fate**. Join our fight for **NO PLEA DEAL** for Abrams. We support the maximum jail time allowed for two misdemeanor animal cruelty counts, which is 364 days in jail and up to \$5,000 in fines for each count.
