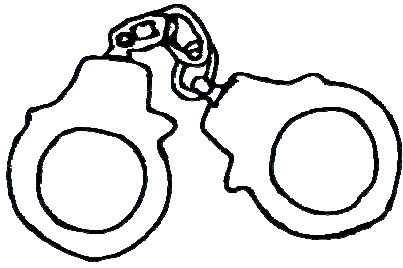

ELLA'S STORY

On March 12, 2008, police were called to a shocking scene at the former residence of Christine Abrams in Cocoa. Police were horrified by what they found: the decomposing body of Ella, Abrams' one year old three-legged German Shepherd dog, who had been locked in a crate with NO FOOD OR WATER for months. Ella's frail white paw stuck out through the bars that were her prison and her agony, as if she were reaching for the bag of food that was only feet away.

While Ella suffered a slow torturous death, starving and crying, with no one to hear her pain-filled whimpers, Christine Abrams was dancing and partying, smiling and giggling, as she bragged on her MySpace page.

The cruel and senseless death of Ella is not the first misfortune Ella endured at the hands of Abrams. When Ella was 9 months old, Christine Abrams tethered Ella, and left her neglected and unsupervised for an unknown length of time which resulted in Ella's leg being badly strangled. The damage from the tether was so extensive that Abrams had Ella's leg amputated.
